

LESSON PLAN
LETS GO TO WORK

SUBJECT AREA: CAD DRAFTING

GRADE LEVEL: 9-12

LENGTH OF PROJECT: TWO WEEKS

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Students will find job opportunities in the oil patch. They are to assume, that will include, any related supporting industry.

GATHERING INFORMATION: Students will graph those jobs available for two weeks from want ads, EDD, PIC, TV, ETC.

OBJECTIVE: Students will be able to identify entry-level skills necessary for employment. The class as a group will then graph those skills common to all jobs.

WRITE: The student will write a job description that is of interest to them and give WHY and HOW to reach that goal. Each student will report to the class using CAD techniques, graphs, charts, text and plot copies for other students as requested.

COLLECTION: Each student must pick five other jobs of interest to them other than they're own and place in their CAD portfolio.
