With the third most active wells and the fourth ranked oil producing county in the state, Fresno County makes a significant contribution to California's oil and gas industry.



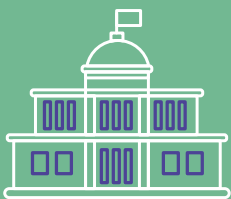
